



Study overview

- Study: 2005-2009
- Method: Closed role play
- Data: requesting, disagreeing acts
- Population: 164 German Working Professionals
- Research aim: what is GWP pragmatic knowledge concerning politeness

Theory: Requesting

- Directive getting someone to do something as intended by the speaker
- Potentially face threatening freedom of action
- Politeness = you have option for non-compliance
- Strategies:
- ✓ Conventional indirectness: can you, could you, would you
- ✓ <u>Internal mitigation:</u> possibly, a little, sort of, etc
- ✓ External mitigation: preparators, explanations

Polite Request Pattern

I hate to bother you but could you possibly

send that report as soon as possible?

My team needs it for a presentation we are giving next week.

Theory: Disagreeing

- Communication of contrary belief or opinion
- Directive abandonment of opinion for good of speaker
- Potentially face-threatening: threatens cooperation
- Politeness = minimise differences; maximise agreement
- Strategies:
 - ✓ Avoid explicitly disagreeing
 - ✓ Partial agreement
 - ✓ Offer other suggestions

Polite Disagreeing Pattern

I understand your point, however I am wondering if it would be better to look at an alternative.


Request Data

Those Americans never keep a promise! It's always the same thing! They all promise to do stuff and then don't follow through!! I need that report!!





Explicit disagreeing




A: I think dressing in Bavarian costumes would be a great idea

I thought the video conference was scheduled for Thursday




I think that's a mistake. Um I wrote down on my notice that we will have the conference on Wednesday, I think you mixed up the date.


German norms
